Jason Walpole, 155 lbs., defeated C. Mysaguirre from South Indy, in three rounds. Jason used straight jabs and crosses effectively, moving his opponent around the ring. Jason peppered punches to the head and body, and worked inside at every opportunity.

Over the course of three rounds, Kenton drew four standing-eights, ending the bout in the third when the referee stopped the contest.

Chase Combs-Kregor, 13 years old, 106 lbs., made his amateur debut against Evansville's N. McReynolds. Chase drew a standing-eight against his opponent in the second round, however the hometown boy took home the win in a very close match that had the crowd on its feet.
